Comments to the Author

The topic of research are very interesting and potential to be well publicized. The results of this study provide a complete illustration related to medical problems that occur in HD patients. Although there is not very strong showing innovation, data from this report is very important and could be provide benefits in clinical practices in HD units which aims to share experiences.

Several mistakes were found in the manuscript such as :

1. Brand names as like "Novalgin" must be replaced by its generic name
2. Inconsistencies in writing "methampiron" or "methampyron" should be "methampyrone"
3. The generic name of "diphenhidramine" should be "diphenhydramine"
4. The word "fourthy" should be replaced with "fourty"
5. There are also need for complete terminology at the beginning of writing for some abbreviations

Comments to the Author

The manuscript shows a very factual data and potential to be a reference for practitioners. The data provides a well interpreted fact related to HD patients and the problem may be occurred and how the practitioners in Indonesia may handle it. However some emphasis should be carefully taken to explain the data:

1. The author should not create a conflict of interest as the Brand names came out through out the manuscript.
2. The author should add the data of efficacy of each treatment. This is important as the author has stated the efficacious statement for the therapy throughout the manuscript e.g. "was managed", "was reduced", "was ameliorated".
3. The drug name consistency should be re-checked
