TITLE: Assessment of Geographical Indications with special reference to Agriculture in India

ABSTRACT: The new National IPR Policy came in the year of 2016 which focused to strengthen the IPR framework in the country. It has seven objectives to create public awareness about economic, social and cultural benefits of IPRs among all sections of the society.
