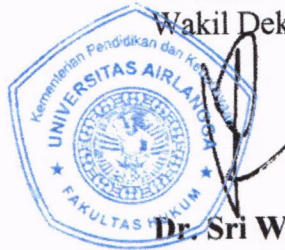

**MANUSCRIPT DETAILS**

**TITLE:** The Evolution of the Dispute Settlement Mechanism in Preferential Trade Agreements (PTAs): The Case of Indonesia

**ABSTRACT:**

The dispute settlement mechanism (DSM) under preferential trade agreements (PTAs) is crucial to ensure adequate implementation and enforcement of commitments among contracting parties. The DSM has evolved from



political/diplomatic styles with a low level of legalism to judicial styles with a high level of legalism. Indonesia has also experienced this evolution process in its PTAs. This article aims to show the evolution of the DSM in Indonesian PTAs, analysing a number of related factors behind this trend. This article argues that the evolution of the DSM from the GATT to WTO; Indonesia's participation in regional trade agreement, that is, ASEAN; the influence of trade partners; the existence of domestic factors; and the ongoing WTO dispute between contracting parties encourage the evolution of the DSM in Indonesian PTAs from political styles to more judicial styles with a high level of legalism.
