We can now come back to you with a decision about the article you submitted to the Journal of International Relations and Development.

The specific comments are as follows:

Editors' Comments:

Please keep the international readership of our journal in mind when revising the manuscript and try to a) set Indonesia in a comparative context (see also point 6 of Reviewer 1) and b) give a basic overview of the Indonesian case. How does the political system work? Who are the relevant parties? What are the important political cleavages in Indonesia and who do the parties represent? This combined with the literature review should lead to clear policy expectations from a realist/liberal/constructivist point of view. It would help if you could use these while discussing the national and international policy positions to show why your interpretation is the correct one.

Reviewers' Comments:

Peer Reviewer #1 (Comments and suggestions for the author(s) (Required)):

I have added only few new remarks to my previous review.

1)The originality of the paper. In the article the author analyses the mechanisms of how the government maintains its own legitimacy in the eyes of people with the help of different economic actions. These mechanisms can be characterized as 'economic nationalism'. From my point of view, the author proposes a very interesting idea that the economic policy of the government can be considered in the context of political identity problems. This interesting research question as well as the original approach to economic policy make the article valuable for academic community.
