Reviewer A Comments:

Changes which must be made before publication:

The paper presents an interesting view Analysis of Flow, Attitudes and Competitor Trait as Moderator Variable. However, I was expecting to see an explanation about threats to validity (internal, external and constructive). Such explanation would give more strength to the paper. Further, references shall be enriched through the literature view, even with recent papers (2016, 2017, 2018).

Reviewer B Comments:

Suggestions which would improve the quality of the paper but are not essential for publication:

The paper provides a quite interesting and timely topic. However, there are important issues that need to be addressed. All of the suggestions will be listed here and the necessary items repeated in the next section. The comments are listed according to the subsections of the paper.

Due to multiple occasions of unusual sentence structure and lexical choices, proof-reading and grammar revision of the entire paper is necessary.

Abstract

Authors should depersonalize the manuscript ("we used purposive sampling"). Additional short description of advergame concept should be added to the abstract. Academic (scientific) contribution of the paper should be described more clearly.

Introduction

Additional sources would be beneficial (page 2, lines 3-13, 21-22, 34-38). Additional explanation of the significance of game player type (page 3, lines 5-8)

Literature Review and Hypothesis

Authors should avoid repetition of the text, especially in the same (sub)section.

Graphic representation of model used in hypotheses testing would be highly beneficial. Competitor traits should be additionally elaborated (it is not clear what the variable represents).

Methodology

It is unclear why is total population described as infinite (additional clarification is advised). It is stated that variable flow is measured with a 4 item statement. How are the remaining 3 variables measured?

Furthermore, statement items should be clearly specified and cited.

Discussion

There are several instances of unclear sample attributes and derived conclusions. The most important instances are listed as follows:

- "Most of the respondents are male (92,6 %). This means that the advergame genre of adventure is most preferred by men." Not necessarily. May it be due to the biased sample? Are there any comparable values from the literature review?

- "Thus it can be concluded that the game player is a productive age" - unclear.

- "The respondent have played game most respondents more than 2 years ago (80%)." – unclear.

The sample is described as highly educated while being between 15-25. Is this correct? Reported average advergame playtime 4 hours per day. How was that measured? Additional elaboration of the sample is highly advised.

Additional elaboration of data in Table 1 is necessary:

Where do original estimates in Table 1 originate from? What kind of test is used in the value of significance? How is CR interpreted? How was moderating variable tested? Comprehensive elaboration of the used methodology is necessary.

Result and Future research

As several parts of the paper seem unclear at this point and will acquire additional elaboration, it is difficult to analyze the derived conclusions.
