

ABSTRACT

This research is purposed to know if there is an influence of conformity and perception about authoritarian parenting style to juvenile delinquency. There are three questions research formulated: 1) Is there any influence between conformity and perception about authoritarian parenting style to juvenile delinquency? 2) How far those two predictors (conformity and perception of authoritative education system) influence juvenile delinquency? 3) Which predictor could influence juvenile delinquency better: conformity or perception of authoritarian parenting style?

This research is included in explanatory research. It was conducted on junior high school students with amount of research's subjects 209 people and consisted of grade 7, 8, 9 students. The instrument to collect the data were questioner of conformity which are consisted of 25 questions, questioner of authoritarian parenting style which was arranged by Henny Nur Rahmania and consisted of 26 questions, and questioner of juvenile delinquency which are consisted of 29 questions. Questioner of conformity and juvenile delinquency had been tried-out to 71 students of eighth and ninth grade. The method applied in analyzing the data was doubled regression statistic technique, aided with SPSS statistic version 16 program.

From the analysis, it can be concluded that regression model $Y = 15,14 + 0,727X1 - 0016X2$. $X1$ (conformity) being the best variable to influence juvenile delinquency. It could be seen from coefficient $X1$, the result was 0,727. Besides, it was also obtained that percentage of quantity $X1$ and $X2$ in influencing Y was 19,3%, with significance of 0,00. This shows that there is a significant influence of conformity and perception about authoritarian parenting style to juvenile delinquency.
