Reviewer 1:

1. Overall the manuscript has many grammatical mistakes and many confusing sentences.
2. The material and method section should be rewritten again with more accuracy as an example, unit of pg/ml is not for absolute count of cells.
3. As the authors mentioned, SLEDAI is more sensitive and relevant in assessment of SLE disease activity. So, why the authors did not use this index for SLE disease activity assessment?

4. The authors should explain about sample collection and PBMC isolation.
5. FBS is not a suitable staining buffer.
6. The staining procedure for Th17/Treg should be rewritten again.
7. The authors should mention about flow cytometer instrument.
8. Flow cytometry graph should be included in result section.

Reviewer 2:

- 1- Why have the samples been chosen only from the female population?
- 2- How the size of Samples has been calculated?
- 3- The type of Flow Cytometry device was not mentioned.
- 4-It was better to use Flow cytometry images.
- 5- Acknowledgement needs to be added.
- 6- The number of the references should be reduced to 35.
- 7- The Introduction section is long.
