

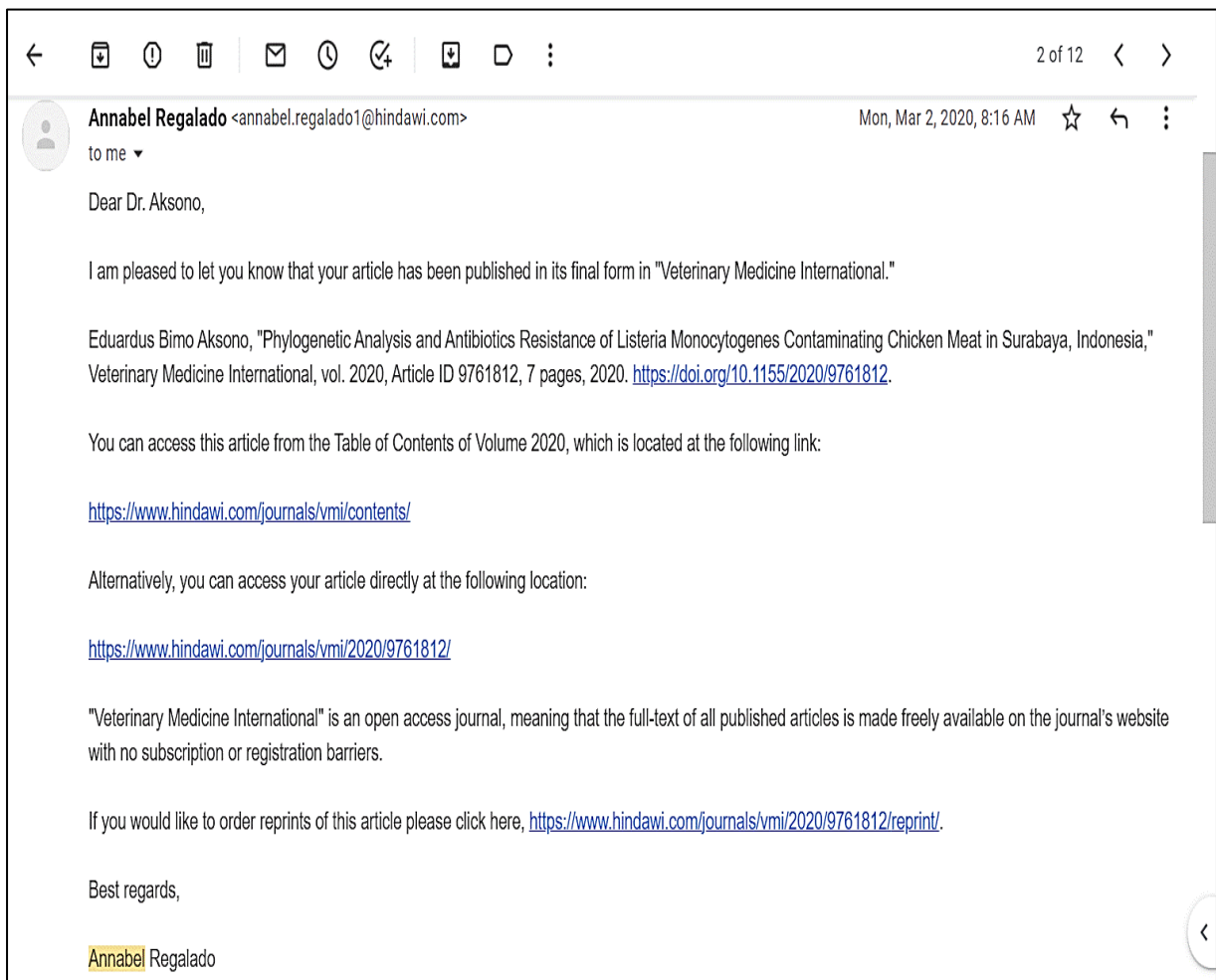
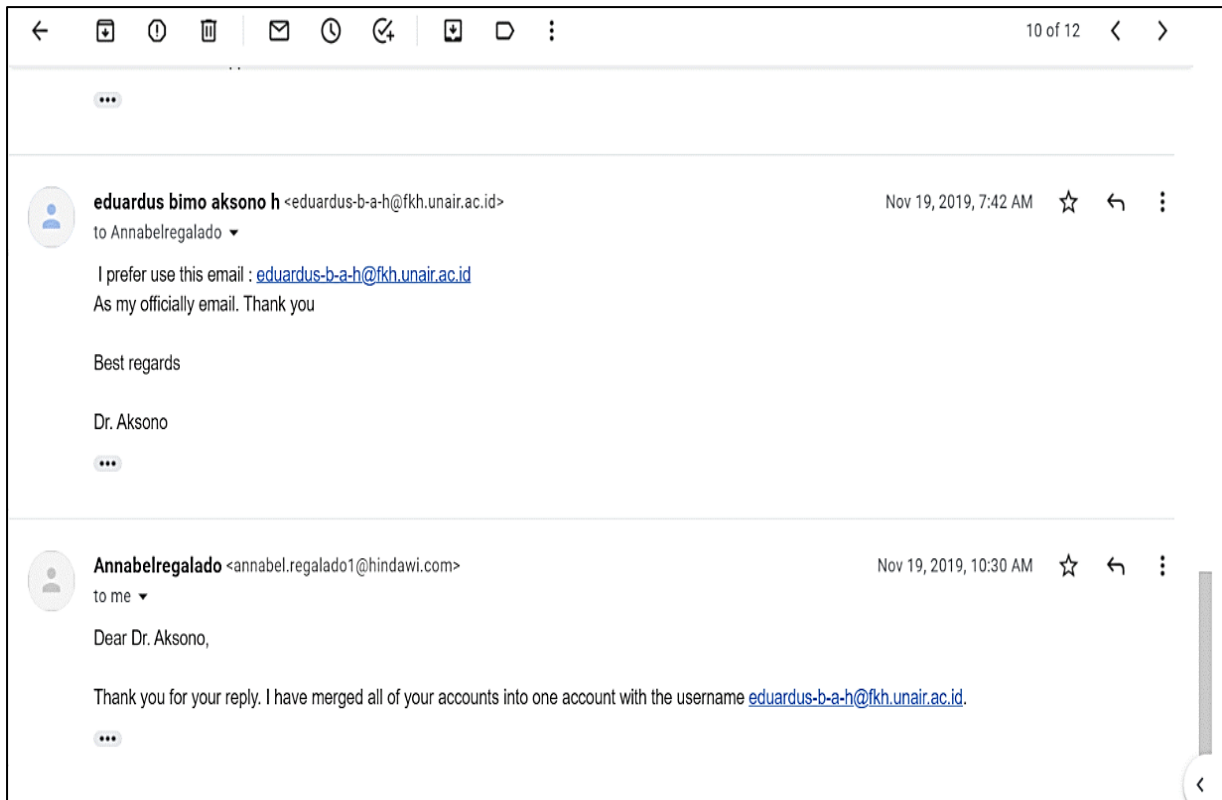

The works fall perfectly within the journal scope. In my opinion, this manuscript should be accepted after major corrections according to the following comments: #1 Authors should explain more details about samples collection, particularly on the consideration of selecting places (supermarkets, mobile vendors, and traditional markets) of which samples were collected. It should be clearly explained how the authors chose chicken meat samples as the representatives of Surabaya and why did the samples from those places have been selected? #2 Authors should clearly explain the reason of using Ampicillin, Amoxylin sulbactam, Cefotaxime, Meropenem, Sulfamethonazole-trimetophrim for antibiotics resistance test. Consider the recent and up-to-date references list of antibiotics used for antibiotics resistance test. #3 The results are interesting but not well explained. Discussion is still needed to be strengthened. Authors should improve relevance of discussion and provide several previous similar researches to discuss the results more details and comprehensive. The relevance and up-to-date references should be cited to support the discussion and also introduction sections. Update and an increase of citations from the last 3-4 years would be welcome. The topic of this manuscript falls within the scope of Veterinary Medicine International
