Title	C	A User-centered Design for Redesigning E-Government Website in Public Health Sector The rising awareness of information transparency and the increasing citizen participation in "healthy living for healthy societies" campaign, especially via electronic system, have promoted the effectuation of e-government service in public health sector. As one of the government agencies, Surabaya Health Department (SHD), Indonesia, is responsible to provide public health services and to administer health-related policies in Surabaya city. The department has been utilizing an official website to deliver its tasks and responsibilities to Surabaya society. However, the website was built mostly based on the department's perspective and internal consensus, without a proper requirement gathering from users and stakeholders. This subjectivity has caused some essential requirements in a public health system unfulfilled, thus nullified the website goals. This study aims to redesign the official SBD website to improve the information dissemination quality and the user experience. The website development follows user-centered design (UCD) methodology in four stages, i.e., specifying the context of use, gathering business requirements from the users and the stakeholders, designing the solution based on the user requirements, and evaluating the proposed solution. The output of this study consists of user requirements, user task analysis, and a redesigned SHD website prototype. The heuristic evaluations between the existing and the new redesigned websites demonstrate the improvement of user experience. The scores of all heuristic indicators of the new website are increased compared to the scores of the existing website. The UCD also enables the user identification and the corresponding requirements more comprehensively. One of the examples is the inclusion of specific requirements for person with color-blind and person with dyslexia to redesign the SHD website.
