1	<p>Methods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✚ The title does not reflect the paper when it compared to the developed model and discussion. The model is overidentified. I have two alternative recommendation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If the authors stick on the paper content, the title better changed to be: The Influencing factors of ITPC Presence. With model: $ln = 0 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + +5 + 6 +$ - If the authors stick on title, the authors must change their model, their literature, their discussion and their recommendation. With simple repaired model be: $ln = 0 + 1 + 2 +$ ✚ The perception of the geographical distance variable in the model (formula 2 and table 2) is the distance between national capital. It differs from line 28 page 11, which distance proxied from transportation cost. Which one is true? ✚ The geographical distance variable is not significant for developed countries model, t is okay if variable has not significant effect. This paper will be better if the authors can explain why this variable not significant and explain it related with the hypotheses 4.

3	<p>Interpretation:</p> <p>please clarify the interpretation of geographic distance variable and ITPC variable.</p>	
4	<p>Other comments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ please enrich the literature with the product cycle theory. In this statement, i don't see the in depth relevance with the existing of ITPC with endowment factor that boost the export. Because the market is changing. Maybe the authors can add the theory of stable allocations and market design by Alvin E. Roth. (Just suggestion). ○ The keywords can be : ITPC, non-oil and gas exports value, Indonesia, global value, developing country, developed country.

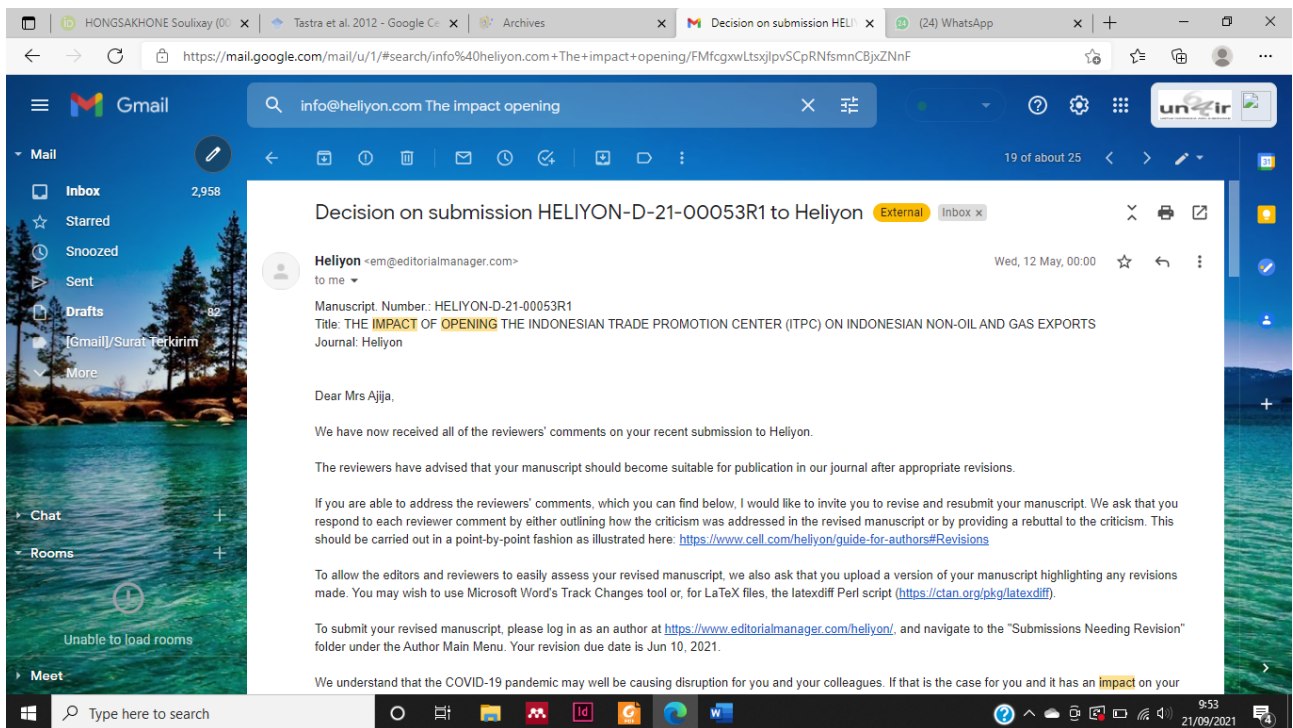

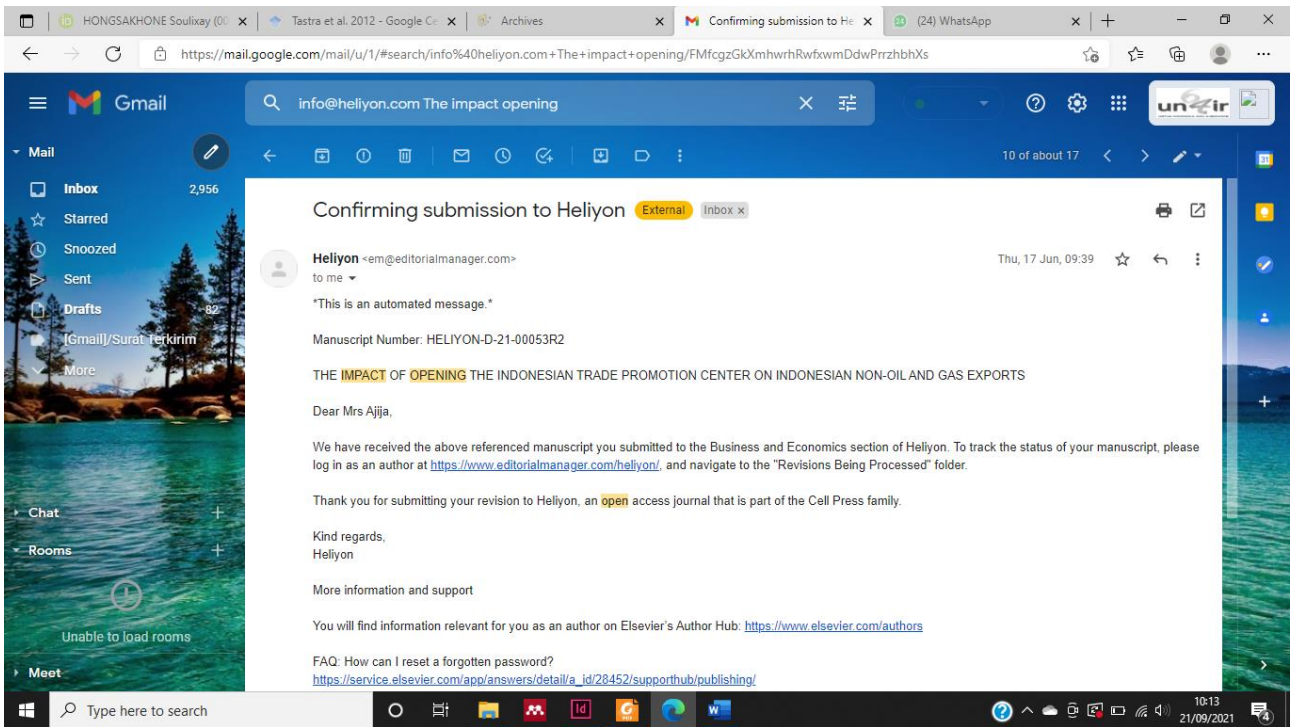

PP.9 Line 39: The sentence "EPA services have the potential to generate the free riders". What do the authors want to emphasize? in my opinion, in term of externalities theory, free-riders probably becomes cost, doesn't it? If the authors get the same idea with me: so please insert this sentence: "The social cost of EPA can increase due the rent-seeking and misuse of information by unauthorized parties" and delete "EPA have the potential to generate free riders". 3. PP.13 Line 17: Tabel 4.4 is it typo? 4. PP.16 Line 22. please insert this sentence before the next sentence in line : In global value model, the existence of IPTC can increase the value of Indonesia's non-oil and gas exports by 22%. In the developing country model, it is able to increase Indonesia's exports by 50%. And in the developed country model, the presence of the IPTC will increase Indonesia's exports by 38 percent. Based on the increase in export value, it is recommended that the Indonesian government should maintain and expand the presence of IPTC to the developing countries and keep maintaining IPTC in developed countries and global markets. 	-

1	<p>The article is focused on a topic that is relevant for both academia and policy decision making. Further, the research question (i.e., why its important the role of ITCP) is quite interesting. However, despite the authors cover an interesting topic, I have some significant concerns with the article. I detail some major concerns below.</p> <p>Eliminate acronym (ITCP) from the title</p>	

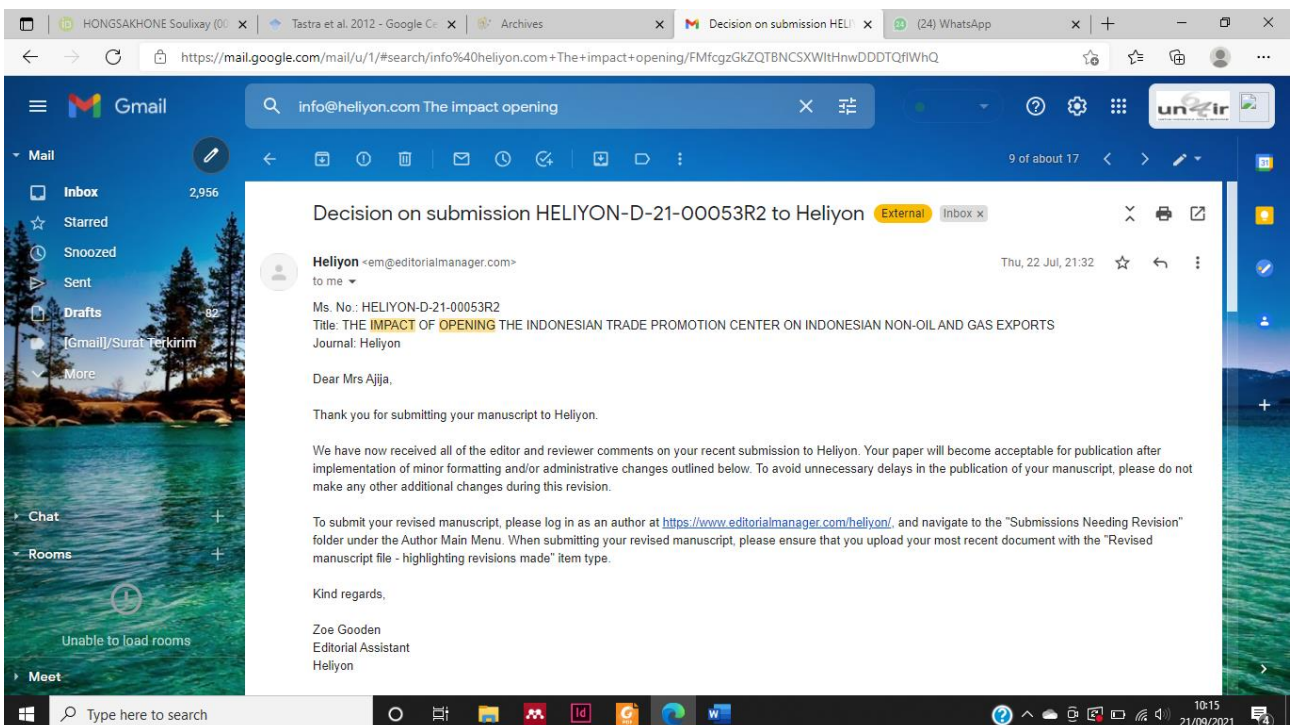
2	<p>Methods:</p> <p>The definition of GDP per capita is incorrect, the one given in Table 2 refers to GDP only. GDP per capita is GDP divided by population. Why did you use GDP per capita as a measure and not just GDP as a whole? the other variables are not per capita, homogenize if not the regression does not go. In fact seeing the values of tab 3 there is discordance. And the panel regression model predicts homogeneous quantities. Why there are only positive variables to the proposed hypothesis? we could evaluate and insert them: 1) if there is a negative image of the state as a debtor or other; 2) its reputation at the international level; 3) barriers to entry/exit for non-oil and gas exsport; 4) any tariff barriers (e.g. customs duties) for exports to countries outside the free trade area; 5) excise duties for this type of product; 6) international trends (fluctuations) in supply and demand for non-oil and gas products.</p> <p>I think the distance variable has a negative impact on transportation costs.</p>	-
3	<p>Results:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review the results in light of previous comments • The conclusion section are too modest and lack limitations to such research, e.g., why some variables were used instead of others. 	-
4	<p>Interpretation:</p> <p>the variables chosen I think were chosen to support the hypotheses and the research question, but they are all positive variables, so they already have the answers inside. review the GDP variable per capita.</p>	-
5	<p>Other comments:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. I think it would be useful to review the variables, not the method, and a section where the critical issues are highlighted. 2. I hope these comments will help the authors to improve their manuscript, good luck! 	-
