MANUSCRIPT DETAILS

TITLE: Interest Rate and Supply Response of Palm Oil Producers in Indonesia

ABSTRACT: Supply response analysis is a feasible topic in agricultural economics. Do the Indonesian palm oil producers respond to the expected interest rate (i.e. cost of borrowing) for their replanting decisions? This study aims to estimate the supply response function of the Indonesian palm oil producers (state-owned, private, and smallholder) by considering the impact of interest rate. Other response variables are relative price of palm oil to coconut oil, relative price of palm oil to rubber, and government expenditure. The extended Nerlovian model by Mohammad and Tang (2005) is employed with application of autoregressive distributed lag (ARDL) procedure. It covers annual data between 1970 [1979] and 2017. The empirical results suggest a long-run relation of Indonesia's palm oil supply response function, except for smallholders. In the long-run, a negative expected real interest rate increases palm oil output, especially the state-owned and private-owned producers. Interest rate remains infeasible for smallholders even though in the short-run. The three categories of palm oil producers are responsive to other supply variables viz. their relative prices, and government expenditure in the short-run. Similar findings are found when money supply is being used to capture monetary policy.
