The topic of the paper is interesting as well as the potential academic contribution of the work, but the Authors should improve the work according to the following indications.

1. In the introduction, the Authors should discuss more international situation, regulations, and approaches, and should motivate the research to be of high interest for a even broader group of addressees.

2. Literature review is poor, and should be extended. Moreover, the Authors should explain how their study fill the gap in the literature. Finally, the following study should be considered:

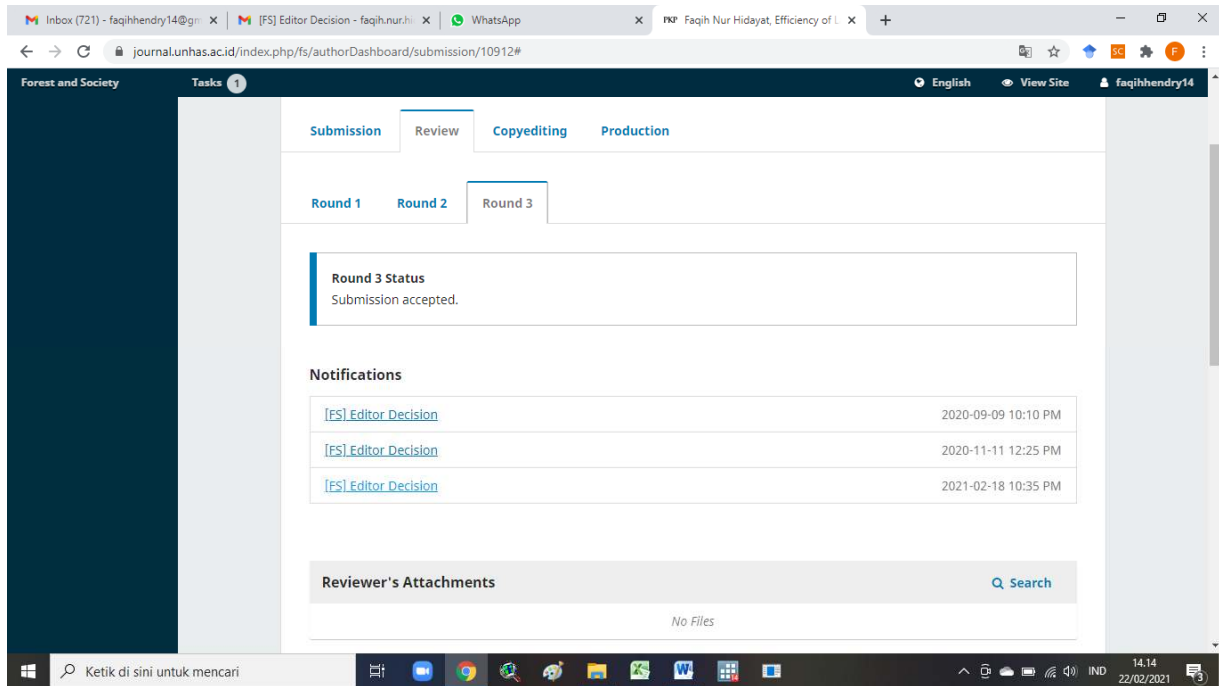

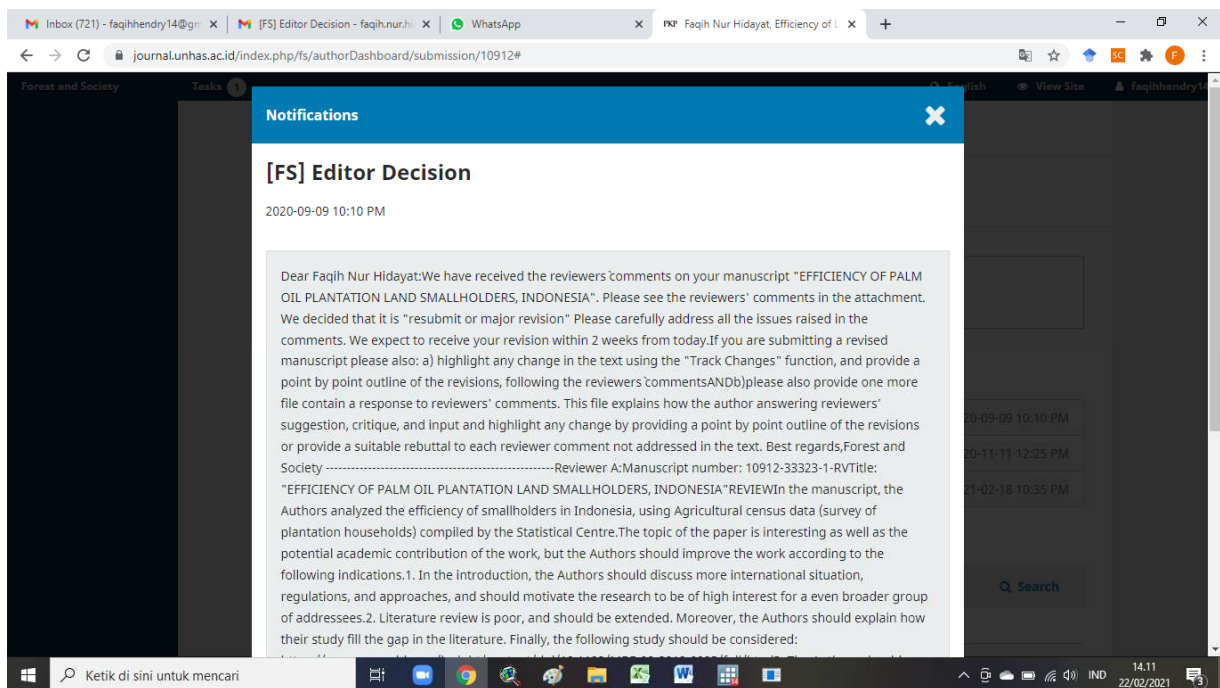

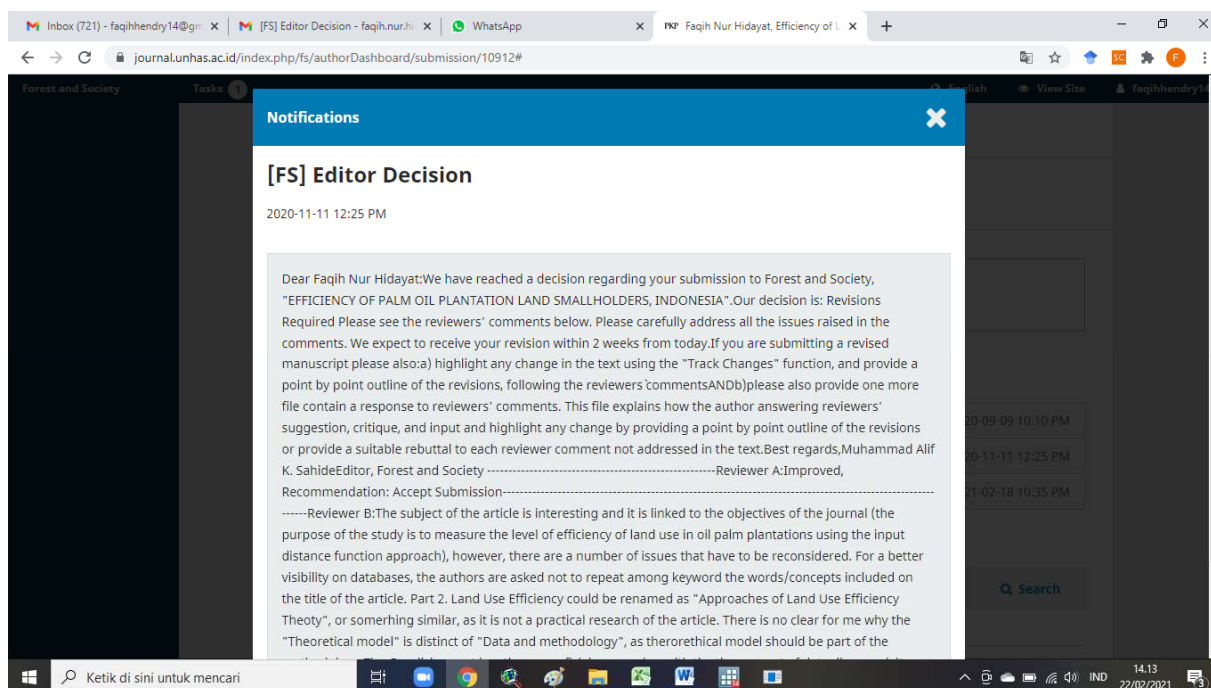
