## SYNOPSIS

The Housebreaker of Shaddy Hill is a story about a young man named Johnny Hake, who has a nice family (a wife and four kids) and has a good job. His parents were divorced when Johnny Hake was five years old. Johnny Hake lives in suburban area called Shaddy Hill. He is unlucky on his career. He is fired from his job. The last story, *The Swimmer*, is a story about a man named Neddy Merril who lives in a suburban area but acts as glamourous city gentlemen. The story tells how Neddy swims into pool to pool until he gets home. In his journey, he makes a stop and do drinking and party with his rich group of friends. However, beneath this security and comfort, he lives in a fake and unhappiness life. The experiences lead him into the misfortune that pushes him down in the social ranks and his world. He loses track of friends and does not even know about their moves or illnesses. He cheats on his wife, abandons his mistress, and consequently ends up alone.
