The phenomenological approach methodology is chosen very appropriately for the given topic. The sample size is sufficient for the topic, the inclusive and exclusion criteria are appropriately selected. The process of evaluating and analyzing the results is clearly and comprehensibly described.

The discussion is in some places too general. In the discussion, I recommend a more analytical-synthetic view of the findings and own interpretation, which is also expected in qualitatively focused studies.

I recommend to specify the Conclusion of the article more on the basis of the findings.

Table 2 is not mentioned in the text. I recommended to explain the abbreviation "PKK".


In the text does not state whether the study was approved by the ethics committee. This needs to be added.

Mastectomy can cause changes in appearance, which can affect women's body image, self-concept, and social interaction. Emotional intensive coping and problem-solving intensive coping are coping strategies used by women after mastectomy. **Conclusion:** Breasts are synonymous with femininity, beauty, and attractiveness. Therefore, many women feel that they have lost their femininity and self-confidence after losing their breasts due to mastectomy.
