
## **Detail Skripsi**

Abstrak:

This study deals with analyzing the cultural words found in Twilight novel. The writer want find out the types of cultural words in the English version of Twilight novel and analyze them to identify and most frequently applied translation procedures used in the Indonesian translation of Twilight novel was translated by Lily Devita Sari and published by PT Gramedia Pustaka Utama in 2008 based on Newmark's theory. Therefore, the objectives of this study are to investigate the types of translation procedure used by the translator. And based on the findings and the discussion of the study, it can be concluded that there are 4 basic categories of cultural words that are presented in the novel they are: ecology, material, social, and organization. The type of cultural words mostly found is material consists of food, artifact, house, transportation, clothes, and communication. From 100 samples of cultural words, there are 52 (52%) cultural words categorized into material, 25 (25%) cultural words categorized into ecology, 18 (18%) cultural words belonged to organization, and the rest were 5 cultural words that belonged to social (5%). In translating the cultural words in the novel, the study shows that the translation procedure applied by in the novel was transference, transposition, naturalization, cultural equivalent, componential, through-translation, literal, notes, addition, and glossaries, couplet, paraphrase, descriptive equivalence, and synonym. Transference procedure is the mostly used in translating cultural words found in the novel.
