SYNOPSIS

He interrupts Piggy's speaking. He also asks the capability of Ralph as a chief.

The other night, when the firewatchers are sleep, a dead parachutists flows down to the island. As they wake up, and see the dead parachutist, they are afraid because they think him as a beast. Then, they report to Ralph.

Eventually, Ralph and Jack and the other boys decide to hunt the beast. In the hunt, they meet a pig. They tries to kill it, but the animal escapes. Then, they hold the ritual killing, and Robert pretends to be a pig. Then, all the boys jab to Robert.

Then, the tribe sets out to hunt a pig, and they are successful. Jack cut the pig's throat, and gives the head of the pig as a gift for the beast.

Meanwhile, Simon who wanders alone in the forest meets the head of the pig which is covered by the flies. Suddenly, the pig's head as if talks to him. Then, Simon is unconscious. As Simon wakes up, he wanders through the forest. Then, he finds the dead parachutists man, who they think as a beast in advance, and decides to inform the others.

However, when Simon appears from the darkness of the forest, the other boys think him as a beast. Therefore, they kill him.

One night, Jack and his tribe steal Piggy's glasses in order to make a fire.

Furthermore, Ralph, Piggy, Sam and Eric go to take Piggy's glasses back. Yet, Jack doesn't want to give it back.

Afterwards, they are quarrel, and start to fight man to man. While they are quarrel, Roger pushes a big rock down to the slope toward Piggy. Piggy is dead.

Furthermore, Jack hurls his spear toward Ralph and is followed by the other boys. Ralph escapes, and hides.

Yet, Wherever, Jack hides, Jack and the others chase him. Eventually, Ralph is saved by a naval officer.
