Reviewer #1: Clearly there is an interaction of host immune responses in co-existing helminth infections and TB. Whether this interaction alters the clinical outcomes needs to be seen.

Many studies done so far, have not been able to demonstrate an influence of helminth infection on latent or active atb.

This study too, although done very methodologically does not show any direct effect.
