The analysis shows us that the shooting of the albatross represents both the violation of nature and man, and other features of the poem, notably the sun, moon and weather. Albatross, a bird of omen, has proven that it has a power to control over the journey of and the mariner also, through its companion with nature. The event that mariner kills the albatross is an important starting points for other continued events, in which the mariner surrounded by eery subjects and qualities. In short, we can say that albatross has caused the gothic sense itself.

Eventhough gothic elements deal with supernatural but the events are formed from natural elements. This condition causes the ability of gothic elements to portray some truth in human being's life. The event in which the albatross has been killed by mariner has produced a mysterius atmosphere, e.g. the sun shows his anger by his bloody face. From this example it seem that albatross has power that controls the sun. It is the same with the ordinary human being's life. In the real world, we believe that there is a power beyond human being's life, that controls everything. In this case, we go back to the religious base again.

Gothic elements have a power of stirring emo-

tions, such as fear, despair, and hopeless. When the ice is everywhere, Mariner in his loneliness, since nothing to see. Coleridge's eery subject both for the eyes and the emotions.

The human experience that Coleridge centres in the poem is surely the depression and the serve of isolation that the mariner has to endure for consequence of crime. In relations to human being's life, what just happened to the mariner's life can be happened to human being. The experience of the mariner can be experienced also by ordinary human being since it contains human value. Furthermore the moral lesson is embedded in the poem. It is true to human values, that man love to the others and the crime will its punishment.

Coleridge characteristic that are found in the poem are :

- each actions and each situation is presented in a concrete form in which the details are selected from common experience.
- how unnatural his events, they are formed upon natural elements, and for this reason we believe that.
- the poem has revealed the universal truth about Nature, Life, Death and God.

Nature : Breaking the law of nature will have a punishment.

Life : There is always joy/happiness or sorrow/sadness in life.

Death : The death of soul is possibly found inside human being.

God : There is a power beyond human life which controls human being.

- Coleridge has a vision of nature, especially the dark side of nature.
