

## ABSTRACT

This study is aimed to analyze the process of interference of the English words combined with the bound morphemes *meN-* and *di-* used in Indonesian newspaper *Kompas*.

The approach used in observing the data is morphology approach, i.e. the study of morphophonemic by Sudarno. Sudarno classified morphological process into: affixation, reduplication, and compounding. However, only affixation type is analyzed in this thesis because this type appropriate for analyzing the data.

The data were taken from *Kompas* newspaper, only the economic issues. In collecting the data, the simple random sampling technique were used.

The result of the analysis has shown that there is only a few English words is used combined with bound morpheme *meN-* and *di-*. Basically, the process of binding between the bound morpheme *meN-* and *di-* with free morpheme (English word) follows the rules in bahasa Indonesia. The bound morpheme *meN-* has four allomorphs, i.e. /men/, /mem/, /men/ and /me / that each allomorph alternate for each other based on its environment. The bound morpheme *di-* is not influenced by the preceded phoneme of the free morpheme it is attached to.
