Comments from the editors and reviewers:

-Reviewer 1

I think the idea behind this study is good and worthwhile. However the reporting of the information is not clear.

The abstract does not include the major findings on age, period of time, relationship of perpetrators, educational status and witness. Instead it focuses on what interviews provided and some inferences from this. Please revise to make sure the major findings are reported here.

Major reorganization of the literature review is needed to make it clear and follow in a logical sequence. There are sentences that are not clear. For example the meaning of this sentence is unclear: "However, what comes to the concern is that incest seems to always happen from time to time, and even the number of children who become victims tends to increase." Do you mean it happens repeatedly over time? The number of children increase in relationship to what? Another Unclear sentence: "Incest between adults and underage children is considered sexual harassment while when it is conducted toward adult is categorized as a sexual abuse." I think most would agree that incest is sexual abuse. The authors need to review the literature review to improve the clarity of the writing.

While discussing incest in Indonesia-why report sexual harassment and assault in US? You do not clearly state it is by way of contrast. Not sure why it is included.

The literature review includes this statement: The alternatives which are often chosen by the incest victims are to get out of the house to live with other relatives or to live on the street in a big city. What becomes a concern is that it is highly possible for the incest victims to live astray, get mired in street life, or become even more exploited in the commercial sex industry. Thus, child victims of incest are suffering not only physically and mentally, but are also at risk of having an even more traumatic experience in the future." Do the authors have any studies to support this or is this only anecdotal?

The literature review also seems to go back and forth between rape and incest. Be clear to the reader what you are discussing, Incest is a form of rape, but rape is not always incest. It is okay to begin the section discussing rape then move into incest as a form of rape but don't go back and forth between the two topics throughout the literature review. You also discuss sexual harassment. Not sure you need to include sexual harassment in this paper as this is another topic. Incest may include sexual harassment but there can be sexual harassment to remove the clarity of focus.

Method: Can you provide more information on the type of questions used. Was there a set protocol? What can you tell us specifically about the interviewees, how many of the 14 were neighbors, friends etc. Break them down if possible. Tell the reader how you analyzed the information from the interviewes.

The results section does not just report the results. Within it there is a discussion of the results and referral to other similar studies. This needs to be in the discussion section. In the results, just list the findings, include clearly the results of the interviews.

Summarize findings in discussion then relate to the literature.

- I would like to congratulate the contributor's for choosing a very urgent and important topic to research. A lot more research in this area are urgently needed. The paper has contributed in a substantial way

in addressing the subject matter. Considering the sensitivity of the subject matter and that as a researcher ethical issue in collecting the data must be number one priority, I would like the contributor's to add and address the following questions:

- 1. Please add a short paragraph detailing the recruitment process of the informant
- 2. Please add a short paragraph detailing the data collection technique
- 3. Please comment whether an ethic clearance was obtained before conducting the research
