Reviewer #1: - This paper requires significant editing, as it is not written in sound English

- The aims of the study are too vague: "the relationship of barriers in medication adherence and adherence to treatment".
- Inclusion criteria: "signed an informed consent form" is not necessary.
- In all the text: write DM type2 instead of DM.
- Exclusion criteria: "Patients diagnosed with DM recently (within less than a month) and those diagnosed with type 1 DM were excluded from the study" in a cross-sectional study, these are not exclusion criteria, as the researcher did not involve them in sampling.
- Explain about the validity and reliability of the questionnaire.
- How to determine the correct sample size?
- Why were 25 patients excluded?
- Start the Discussion with the research findings.

Reviewer #2: Please include ethical issue and analysis method to the abstract.

Please set the key word based on MeSH category.

Please include the Informed consent in ethical Section.

Please provide more detailed information about sampling special about 63 primary healthcare centers and number of people who selected from each center (line 139-41).

Please provide more detailed information about underlying diseases (line 151).

Are these questionnaires culturally adapted in your country? Please provide more information about translating the questionnaires into Indonesian.

Please provide more detail about data collection process.

If possible, please re-write the tables related to the main study variables based on the questionnaire dimensions, not each question.

Please also add the analytical results of each variable to Table 2.

Please add regression table to the manuscript.
