Please, revise the tables 1 and 2: the headings are in contrast to the content. +-12,837 or [127,7-43,3]? Please check some blanks in the text.

Please check your citation according to the specifications of the Journal: Citation:

Cite references in the text by name and year in parentheses. Some examples:

- o Negotiation research spans many disciplines (Thompson 1990).
- o This result was later contradicted by Becker and Seligman (1996).

o This effect has been widely studied (Abbott 1991; Barakat et al. 1995a, b; Kelso and Smith 1998; Medvec et al. 1999, 2000).
