Comments to the Author

I thank the authors for their responses to the reviewers' comments. I am satisfied with the responses and recommend the manuscript for publication in its current form - congratulations!

Reviewer: 2

Comments to the Author

Paper overall now reads well. Some minor points still require attention, viz:

p.2 Para beginning 'Adolescence is...' should add 'sometimes' before 'result'.

p.3 para beginning 'Peer education...', fourth last line should read 'shaping peer educators' behaviour'. This is one of several instances in the text where the possessive apostrophe is misused; editorial checking needed - eg last line of same page should read "educators" not "educator's".

p.5, para beginning 'The thematic analysis...' contains several cases where words have been capitalised – and should not have been.

p. 5, Quotation beginning 'When we were...': the clause inserted in brackets does not fit into the sentence and should be deleted.

p.9 para beginning 'It is apparent...', 'effective to support' should be changed to 'effective in supporting'.

Same para: 'needs to' should be replaced by 'should'.

Finally, some references are incomplete.
