Comments:

The purpose of this paper is to investigate the influence of business strategy and spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance. Furthermore, it investigates whether the influence is mediated by environmental business process. Overall, the concept of this paper is interesting although it suffers from several limitations (both structural and content-wise) and it can be significantly improved re-organising several axis. Furthermore, the author(s) should better fit the purpose of the paper with the scope of the journal.

First of all, the Introduction is not focused. It has trouble getting to the point. Unfortunately, although the paper does take place in an interesting context the way this is presented is rather descriptive. The author(s) could have better positioned this work and contributions which would have not only made the paper more engaging but would have helped pinpoint what the contribution exactly is. To this end, thus, after reframing this work, the author(s) can further look into this issue in this manuscript, and better motivate this study through its main contributions. Therefore, the author(s) may want to shorten the introduction and the focus it the 2-3 ideas that matter. In turn for each one of them explain to the reader what the relevant research gap is and how the paper is going to address it. The author(s) should use the traditional structure, just 4 paragraphs: motivation, gap, method, results, and contributions. Just a clear structure and ideas.

The paper demonstrated an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cited an appropriate range of literature sources. The author(s) analyzed the findings and research gaps from previous researchers and clearly identified hypotheses.

Methodology is not clear. This section should be designed based on the existing literature. In terms of methodology, the author(s) should attempt to enhance the following: (i) What are the questions used? (ii) Is the sample adequate? (iii) Why should companies meet these criteria in order to be included in the sample?

Regarding the implementation of PLS, the item of R square is missing.

The findings' section is also problematic: it is descriptive and generic, and suffers from lack of explanations. There is a lack of cohesion between the goals of the paper, the findings, and the resulting discussion. The results remained at a relatively high level. The author(s) ought to be more transparent regarding the analysis, and better portray the rigor of the research. In the discussion section it is expected to reflect on the outcomes and main contributions, and further reflect upon the theory the author(s) used. Currently, the author(s) merely repeated previous sections in conclusion and made no connections between contributions and the existing literature.

The paper needs to make a clear statement with regards to the theoretical and practical contributions. The paper's central problem resides in that it does not provide a unique and clear contribution to the extant literature. Largely, the author(s) failed to articulate how and why this paper moves the scholarly field forward. The author(s) should dig deeper into the extant literature and discover (and present more comprehensively) a more meaningful reason for this study; one that is more focused in dealing with a clearly identified phenomenon. This would help to focus and justify this study to enlighten the field beyond what is currently known from a research perspective. To this end the last section on the conclusion will need to be revised accordingly. The conclusion should explain to the reader what is novel and what the significant of the findings are.

Finally, when it comes to the limitations, the author(s) should be transparent about the ways that the choices during the study have limited the scope and reach of the findings. This can also open avenues for further research on the topic, and allow the author(s) to reflect upon how future endeavors can address the limitations of this work, but also how this paper can offer opportunities for future research on the topic. Author(s) should answer the following questions in order to make the contribution of the paper explicit in conclusion:

- What does this research tell us that we didn't already know?
- What is the contribution of the most significant results of the paper?
- What are the limitations of this paper and suggestions for future research?

References should be up-to-date.

Comments:

The topic suggested by the authors is relevant and deserves to be explored. The study addresses the critical issue of Business Process Management Journal Business strategy, spiritual capital, and environmental sustainability performance. However, the paper needs further minor revision to become suitable for publication. The comments and suggestions are presented as follow:

- * 1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?
- Yes the paper contains new and significant information adequate to justify publication, but I suggest the Originality/value part of the abstract need modification. The author mention in that ".... This is the first study that employs the current research model showing the comprehensive understanding on how to improve environmental sustainability performance via business strategy, spiritual capital, and environmental management process....". There are many papers published related to this topic, the author also cited some in introduction and literature review and hypothesis development section. Therefore, this sentence in abstract need to be modified.
- 2. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources? Is any significant work ignored?
- The Literature is well written, but in this section after one paragraph of Literature, the author focused in developing hypothesis, I suggest the author should add more paragraphs. The literature are narrow please go deeper.
- * 3. Methodology: Is the paper's argument built on an appropriate base of theory, concepts, or other ideas? Has the research or equivalent intellectual work on which the paper is based been well designed? Are the methods employed appropriate?
- The methodology section is well done!
- * 4. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?
- The results are well done, it is ok that the author compares the results with existing research discussion section, but I suggest having a subtitle (theoretical and managerial implications) under discussion section and explaining those possible theoretical and managerial implications behind their results/findings.
- Also I suggest that, section 3.1 Characteristics of respondents including Table one should move to Methodology and presented after subsection "2.1 Sample and data collection" to follow the academic paper structure.
- * 5. Implications for research, practice and/or society: Does the paper identify clearly any implications for research, practice and/or society? Does the paper bridge the gap between theory and practice? How can the research be used in practice (economic and commercial impact), in teaching, to influence public policy, in research (contributing to the body of knowledge)? What is the impact upon society (influencing public attitudes, affecting quality of life)? Are these implications consistent with the findings and conclusions of the paper?
- The current paper requires including theoretical and managerial implication. The implication is well mentioned in discussion section but need to conclude them as a theoretical and managerial implication. Add theoretical and managerial implication subsection after discussion section.
- * 6. Quality of Communication: Does the paper clearly express its case, measured against the technical language of the field and the expected knowledge of the journal's readership? Has attention been paid to the clarity of expression and readability, such as sentence structure, jargon use, acronyms, etc.
- The quality of communication and readability of the paper is well written. However, I observed minor grammatical issues need to be revised. Revise the minor grammatical errors, syntax, and omissions in the manuscript. Also, be ensuring that all abbreviations are indicated at first mention.

Minor observation

I found out the author section one (1. Introduction) and also the next section (Literature review and hypothesis development) have been numbered as (1......) please correct the section numbering as (1. Introduction, 2. Literature review and hypothesis development, 3......)

I hope that the comments provided could help you improve the quality of the work.

Despite this potentially interesting contribution, some major issues substantially limit the manuscript in its current version.

First of all, the Introduction is not focused. It has trouble getting to the point. Unfortunately, although the paper does take place in an interesting context the way this is presented is rather descriptive. The author(s) could have better positioned this work and contributions which would have not only made the paper more engaging but would have helped pinpoint what the contribution exactly is. The author(s) reframed this work and focused on specific concepts. However, the author(s) could better motivate this study through its main contributions in order to explain to the reader what the relevant research gap is and how the paper is going to address it.

The paper demonstrated an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cited an appropriate range of literature sources. The author(s) analyzed the findings and research gaps from previous researchers and clearly identified hypotheses.

Methodology can be improved. The author(s) added more details about the sample, the profile of respondents and the questions used. However, the description of the questionnaire and the method for data analysis is not clear. It is recommended to study other empirical papers that have been published in this journal in order to describe this section in a similar way.

There is a need to read over the paper to address some minor typos identified. I think "effect" in Abstract - Finding should affect (Second, spiritual capital)

Although the constructs (questionnaire) have been provided, were the questions for the construct based on a Likert scale or a YES or NO response? There is a need to be clear on this. It was stated for environmental sustainability performance but not for the other variables.

Additional Questions:

- 1. Originality: Does the paper contain new and significant information adequate to justify publication?: Yes, the paper does not only focus on the direct influence of business strategy and spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance, it extends the literature by examining the indirect relationship of business strategy and spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance through the environmental management process.

Is any signficant work ignored?: An adequate understanding of the relevant literature has been demonstrated. throughout the paper, a careful selection of relevant literature has been applied.

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"Business strategy, spiritual capital, and environmental sustainability performance: mediating role of environmental management process" - BPMJ-11-2021-0718.R3

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This study aims to investigate the influence of business strategy and spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance. Furthermore, it investigates whether the influence is mediated by environmental management process. This study is designed as quantitative research. A survey method is employed for collecting 454 data from the managers/owners of Indonesian manufacturing micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs). The partial least squares structural equation modeling (PLS SEM) is used to test the hypothesis. A mediation research approach is employed to describe the relationship between research variables.

The findings demonstrate the following important results. First, business strategy affects environmental sustainability performance. Second, spiritual capital affects environmental sustainability performance. Third, environmental management process fully mediates the effect of business strategy on environmental sustainability performance. Fourth, environmental management process partially mediates the effect of spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance.

This study addresses the issue of previous research gaps. By employing a mediation research framework, this study argues that environmental management process has a mediating role in business strategy-environmental sustainability performance relationships. Furthermore, it addresses the lack of empirical studies regarding the effect of spiritual capital on environmental sustainability performance via environmental management process. Thus, this research emphasizes the role of management or business process in developing resource-based view (RBV), natural resource-based view (NRBV), sustainability theory, and MSMEs' management practices.

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
