Editor and Reviewer comments:

Reviewer 1: The manuscript has the potential to fill knowledge gaps in medication safety. However, some changes need to be made to give its readers better clarity when reading the manuscript. I hope that the following comments can help improve the quality of the manuscript.

General

In general, the manuscript has already followed the article structure specified by RSAP. However, I found some sections to be missing important details. In addition, there are some numbering inconsistencies within the manuscript that should be rectified.

"Introduction"

It is stated in the introduction that the objectives of the study are to (a) identify DRPs associated with medication misadventures among people with dementia or cognitive impairment and (b) pay more attention to the DRPs. I would recommend specifying the second objective to be associated with a clearer research question (e.g., to identify risk factors of DRPs or to estimate the prevalence of DRPs)

"Methods"

Data collection and extraction methods are lacking. I would recommend using the PRISMA checklist to help ensure that all items have been sufficiently reported in the systematic review.

There are discrepancies between search strategy written in the "Abstract" (from PubMed and Scopus) and "Method" (from PubMed, Scopus and MedRxiv). Please make this information consistent.

As shown in Figure 1.0, outpatient studies are excluded. Is this intentional/planned? Inclusion and exclusion criteria are currently not clearly reported.

"Results"

Table 3 is missing from the manuscript

"Discussion"

Some information regarding most common drugs involved in DRPs are discussed twice (p16 l8-15 and p17 l35-40). I would recommend removing duplicates and combine all info to the subsection "Most Common Drugs Involved in DRP" Limitation of the study (e.g. reviewing English language publications only) should be stated under "Discussion" or stated as exclusion criteria under "Methods"

I recommend writing suggestions on what kind of future research should focus on to fill in the knowledge gap this study is unable to fill or how the study informs future practice of pharmacists.

Reviewer 2: Great initiative given there is lot of interest in safety of meds due to ADR. Deprescribing is a great tool to lessen risk of meds in elderly patients. I totally support the review and the stratification provided. Hoping to see more studies in future looking at this to have higher # of studies. I see that the number of studies are only 15 (9+6) but this may lead to more findings in future.
