

- -It is advised to re-write the abstract in a way the main findings and research implications are evident from it. Further, it is suggested to remove the qualitative and quantitative stated in bracket and put it properly. "This research uses a mix- method (qualitative and quantitative)."
- -In the introduction, it is important to define what is the meaning of Islamic social finance and the components of it. It seems like the discussion is too much based on zakat.
- -The description of Table 1 needs to be changed. It is not the definition which is shown; but the instruments or tools of ISF. Please change it accordingly. Further, the difference between zakat and alms; qard and qard hasan; and grant need to be explained properly -There are many authors. So please amend all places where you have mentioned only author.
- -Zakat institution allocates zakat, infaq, and sadaqah funds to be integrated with waqf funds... how they are integrated need to be explained properly. What do you mean by integration? There are Shariah rules that cannot be breached in integration. So how do you integrate all these without breaching those rules?
- -In 4.1, the basis for coming up with the proposed model need to be justified and explained clearly.
- -Section 6 needs to be expanded where the implication of the research needs to be written clearly. The points highlighted need to be expanded further.
- -Conclusion seems to be weak. Please provide a proper summary and contribution of the research with future research areas.
- -Since the paper is about Islamic social finance, please define Islamic social finance properly. Right now it is vague.

Reviewer 2: Methods:

- 1. Both qualitative and quantitative methods are not well justified.
- a. It stated that ... "The primary data is obtained from Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and in-depth interviews with seven individuals, who come from various groups such as academicians, practitioners, regulators, and associations...". How the seven experts interviewed were selected?
- b. The authors did not list the questions asked to the expert panel.
- c. Some justifications are needed. Why Average Weighted Index (AWI) approach was used?

1. Where is the result from interviews with expert panels?

Interpretation:

- 1. How did the authors extract the proposed model from the responses of the expert panel?
- 2. The authors should elaborate on the answers to the "research questions" by referring

to the statements of the panel of experts who were interviewed, then support it with previous studies.

3. The authors need to identify clearly any implications of the study to theory.

Other comments:

- 1. The authors should define all acronyms upon their first use. Please check the abstract and other parts of the paper.
- 2. The theoretical issue has not been well explained.
- 3. More recent studies should be accommodated in section 2.2. while explaining the role of zakat and other social finance instruments in attaining the well-being of all. E.g., Bin-Nashwan, S. A., Abdul-Jabbar, H., Aziz, S. A., & Haladu, A. (2020). Zakah compliance behavior among entrepreneurs: economic factors approach. 
