Comments to the Author

All figures and tables should be mentioned in the text of manuscript. Figure 2 and table 1 weren't properly elaborated in Result section - those green arrows should not be only mentioned in Discussion. There were many typographical errors that should be addressed by the Authors.

Reviewer: 2

Comments to the Author

Comments for JCBPP.2020.0438.

- 1. Authors need to improve the language and the writing structure and flow. Authors may use proof reading service in order to do so.
- 2. Authors need to double check the writing of decimal point throughout the manuscript. A point (small dot) should be used to separate the whole number part from the fractional part of a number; not a comma. Example: in the number 36.9 the point separates the 36 (the whole number part) from the 9 (the fractional part, which really means 9 tenths).
- 3. Any abbreviation should be written in a full name for the first mention in the manuscript, followed by the abbreviation in a bracket (A title is not including as part of first mention). Afterwards, authors can use the abbreviation.
- 4. The study design did not provide enough information which would affect the way the results were analyzed and discussed.

Specific comments:

- 1. There is no authentication of the green tea used in this study actually Camellia sinensis; either by herbarium sample or any characteristic analysis such as using finger print (such as IR, HPLC or MS analysis and comparing it with the standard sample).
- 2. The presented work is comparing the results between the epigallocathechin gallate (ECGC) and the green tea (sample). And since green tea is known to contain ECGC, authors should analysed the ECGC contain (qualitatively and quantitatively) in the green tea sample. Only by knowing the quantity of the ECGC in the green tea sample, authors can compare the results /findings to the ECGC standard.
- 3. Authors need to clarify a few things regarding the study design.
- a. What was the control group meant by the authors? Was it normal control group or MCAO model-control group?
- b. How authors confirmed the MCAO rat model was successful to cause neuronal cell necroptosis prior introduction the ECGC / green tea sample?
- c. What was the basis of the dosage used for ECGC and the green tea? Since the ECGC is considered pure (standard), how come the extract/green tea dose was the same to the standard?
- d. Why authors just choose one dose instead of, at least, three doses so the results would be more conclusive either they are dose dependent or not?

- e. How were the ECGC and the green tea sample prepared? What was the method to introduce the sample/ECGC to the animal?
- f. What was the method used to sacrifice the animal by the end of the study?
- g. How was the tissue for histopathological work prepared?
- h. Which statistical analysis was employed to analyzed the data? What was the significant value (p value) used? And, what was the software used to analyzed the statistical value?
- 4. Authors need to clarify a few things regarding the results.
- a. What was/were the indicator(s) used to observe the necroptosis evidence in the descriptive analysis?
- b. Has the histopathological analysis confirmed by a pathologist?
- c. Authors need to include few legends or notes in the presented figure 2.
