- Many factors depends on the radiological outcome of the case of THR besides acetabulum defect. Acetabulular component inclination and version happens to be important factor, quality of bone, clinical, subclinical and delayed infection happens to be major factors for dislocation and osteolysis

in conjunction to acetabular defect preoperatively as suggested by paparosky classification. paparosky classification happens to be a factor in wear of acetabulum which normally gets compensated on reaming and bonegraft and larger size cup placement so acetabular defect doesnit seem to be a big predictor of osteolysis wear and tear heterotrophic ossification and HHS.
