Comments to the Author

- 1. Avoid technical terms. You have to know your audience. If it is to epidemiologists only, it is alright. But, your findings may to policy makers without epidemiology knowledge. Therefore, better make it clear for all or any lay person.
- 2. Please, in method section, simple past and active voice are commonly used.
- 3. In result section, table 1, Which one is the reference category?
- 4. In result section, sequential presentation of findings is important having titles in each section.
- 5. Your discussion is almost good. But, it lacks discussion why the government run health insurance is better than others.

For example, your National Health Insurance (NHI) scheme could be characterized as a government run program with community involvement in scheme design, management, and supervision.

The financial source of the scheme could be mainly the premium contribution of members and subsidy from the central government or else.

While governments are expected to cover the costs of providing a fee waiver for the poorest population groups.

The other point, membership to the government NHI scheme could be voluntary at household level or mandatory based on your scheme. The government NHI scheme benefit package for members could include health-care cost coverage of both outpatient and inpatient healthcare services in public facilities or else.
