equal value. The main conjunctions used to form compound sentences are: And, But, Yet, So, Both, . . . . and, either . . . . or, neither . . . . not, not only . . . . but etc. Complex sentence is a sentence that contains one main idea (called subordinate clause). The subordinate conjunctions used in this type are: because, after, when, as, since, in order to, even if, even though etc. The sentences of legal language contains those two type.

## For example:

1. The Bank notifies the Borrower that there has occured a severe disturbance in the polical or economic situation or other adverse change of circumstances, including without limitation any substantial damage to the Borrower's financial position or any governmental action to condemn, seize or appropriate or to assume control or custody of all or any substantial part of the property of the Borrower or to displace the management of the Borrower, which in the opinion of the Bank imperils the ability of the Borrower to performed its obligations hereunder.

The sentence above contains 7 conjunctions which show the type of compound sentence and 2 subordinate conjunctions which show the type of complex sentences.

2. If the Borrower is required by law to deduct or withold any taxes, commission or other amount with respect to any sums, interest or other amounts payable shall be increased by that amount necessary as will result in receipt by the Bank of the full amount which it would have received if there had been no such deduction or withholding, and the Borrower shall promptly, but in no event later than fifteen (15) days after the date the Borrower is obligated to pay to the competent authority the amount so deducted or witheld, deliver to the Bank the receipts, certificates or other official proof evidencing such payment of the amounts deducted or witheld.

The sentence above contains 10 conjunctions which show the type of compound sentences and 4 subordinate conjunctions which show the type of complex sentences.

Based on two examples above, there are a lot of compound and complex sentences in legal Documents which are showed by many conjunctions and subordinate conjunctions arise in its sentences.
