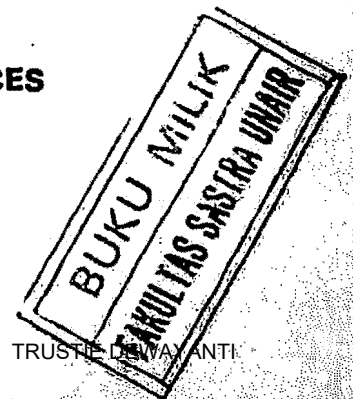

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
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
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Sociolinguistics, as the term itself suggests, is a discipline that is capable of combining linguistics and societal concerns in varying degrees.
