CHAPTER IV CONCLUSION

This thesis deals with theme description of literary work, in this case is the drama Lady Windermere's Fan, through the analysis of the character's conflict. Therefore, the writer wants to describe the theme of this drama by analyzing the conflict of the characters, they are Lady Windermere, Lord Windermere, and Mrs. Erlynne.

Based on the analysis, the writer finds that there are two types of conflict experienced by the characters of this drama which are inseparable one another. One conflict emerge as the cause or the result of the other ones. It also can be seen that most of characters in this drama struggle one another (social conflict) and even there are battles within themselves (inner conflict) because of love. They take love as the basic reason in doing their action, which lead us to the theme description. As depicted in this drama, Lady Windermere is terribly angry since she thinks her husband has scandal. Actually, it happens because she loves him. Lord Windermere is no differnce. His love to his wife makes him submit threats. Meanwhile, Mrs. Erlynne is willing to be thought as a wretched woman

only for saving her daughter's marriage, her daughter's happiness, since she really loves her.

Considering the description above, we actually have had the key word of the theme of this drama, that is love, since it makes the story moves forward through the character's conflict. Love here doesn't only have the power to make a change in them. It can be seen in Lady Windermere that becomes so wicked knowing her husband will invite Mrs. Erlynne in her party.
