CONCLUSION

It shows that if someone has a strong faith in God, this person will have a strong guide of life. On the contrary people who do not have faith in God, he does not have a guide of

life. Without a strong guide of life people won't have a strong personality, and without a strong personality it will be hard for him to survive in facing the problems of life. So with the faith in God, people will reach their life's goal.

The last thing that O'Neill wants to say is never too late to make something better. If there is a will there will be a way to solve the problem. There is nothing that can be reached easily in this life. For reaching the life's goal someone has to try hard. He has to fight and never give up in overcoming the problems. Finally the evil and the bad things will lose and the good things will win. And this can only happen through faith in God and a strong personality.
