

Abstract: Kaposi's sarcoma (KS) is an angioproliferative disorder. It is characterized by the proliferation of spindle-shaped cells, inflammation, edema, and neoangiogenesis. It is categorized as an intermediate neoplasm due to the absence of conventional features of malignancy. KS is associated with patients under antiretroviral therapy, organ transplantation, or immunocompromised. KS's involvement of lymph nodes is quite rare but if present, it is frequently seen in the endemic African form and the epidemic form in HIV-infected patients. Four main clinical presentations of KS have been described: classic, endemic, iatrogenic, and epidemic. The diagnosi of KS is made by history, physical examination, and tissue biopsy. In cases of localized disease, treatment with HAART alone could result in improvement or resolution of the disease. Disseminate disease, however, would require a combination of HAART as well as chemotherapy. Here, we present the case of a 28-year-old female patient who is HIV positive and has a viral load that is not detected. She presented with generalized

lymphadenopathy of 8 months duration. She had no cutaneous manifestations. The lymphadenopathy involved the tonsils, axilla, inguinal, and an unusual site, intraparotid on both sides. After a pathologic examination of the lymph nodes, she was found to have epidemic-type KS and was treated with HAART and chemotherapy. We have not found a published case report of a similar case in our country. This case report aims to make physicians aware of this rare condition and to have a high index of suspicion of KS in HIV patients who present with generalized lymphadenopathy. The early initiation of systemic treatment is lifesaving for these patients.

- 1. The title would be better if it could describe that <u>Kaposi</u> sarcoma in the form of generalized lymphadenopathy without <u>mucocutaneous</u> manifestations is rare.
- 2. In the title, it is advisable to provide the full expansion of the acronym RVI.

Yes, the author has briefly explained the background to writing the case and the uniqueness of the case. It would be more interesting if the author shortly describe the condition of the patient's CD4 and viral load

Kaposi's Sarcoma is rare, especially in patients with CD4 that is not too low (>200), and the viral load is undetectable, so it is necessary to explore and more deeply other risk factors for KS in this patients.
