

**THE EFFECT OF FRESH AND DRY ALOE VERA (*Aloe vera Linn*)
COMPLEMENT IN COMERCIAL FEED TOWARD TO
BROILERS FEED CONVERTION RATE AND
BODY WEIGHT**

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ABSTRACT

The aims of this research was to know about the effect of *aloe vera linn* in commercial feed of *broilers* toward to the body weight and the feed conversion rate. For design study was Completely Randomized Design with Factorial, this research used eight treatments and four replications. All treatment were grouped into P₁D₁ (dry *aloe vera*, dose 0%), P₁D₂ (dry *aloe vera*, dose 0,5%), P₁D₃ (dry *aloe vera*, dose 1%), P₁D₄ (dry *aloe vera*, dose 1,5%), P₂D₁ (fresh *aloe vera*, dose 0%), P₂D₂ (fresh *aloe vera*, dose 0,5%), P₂D₃ (fresh *aloe vera*, dose 1%), P₂D₄ (fresh *aloe vera*, dose 1,5%). Data was analyzed with Analysis of Variance followed by Duncan's Multiple Range Test. The result showed that the effect of *aloe vera linn* in commercial feed of *broilers* toward to the body weight and the feed conversion rate is signifikan to decreased the body weight and did not have to improve the feed conversion rate.
