## **ABSTRACT**

## THE RELATIONSHIP OF KNOWLEDGE, 14-18 YEARS TEENAGE ATTITUDE, AND PARENT'S RESTRICTION TO SEXSUAL BEHAVIOUR PREMARITAL AT RW02 KELURAHAN KLAKAH REJO SURABAYA

Teenagers is an unique individuals. Sexual behaviour premarital is an issue that is currently common among teenagers. This study analyzed the relationship of knowledge, attitudes and parent's restriction to sexual behavior premarital at RW 02 kelurahan Klakah Rejo.

This study is a correlational study. The study population is teenagers at RW 02 Kelurahan Klakah Rejo to amount 60 teenagers which having an age 14-18 years old. Sampling techniques used purposive sampling, samples taken as many as 52 people responden. Variable of this study are a knowledge of sexual behavior, an attitude of sexual behavior, and parents restriction about sexual behavior as an independent variable, and the behaviour of premarital sex act is the dependent variable. Data collection tool used was questionnaire.

Using spearman's Rho test with a Significance importance grade < 0,05. The result of research showed there are a relationship of knowledge (p=0,045; r=-0,279), attitude (p=0,032;r=-0,298), and parent's restriction (p=0,002;r=0,413) with sexual behavior premarital. Correlation produced showed negative relation. Where the higher one of variables, the lower the other variable affected.

To prevent occurrence of the attitude of premarital sex act happened, the teenagers must be fill up spare time with join in karang taruna organization, as well as the role of nurses to give sex education are both can be reduce premarital sex act.
