Comments to the Author

-Your introduction does a good job of presenting the topic, setting up the context, and introducing the problem that your paper will address. However, there are a few areas where it could be improved for clarity and flow:

The transition between the prevalence of CLP and the discussion of treatment procedures could be smoother. Also, the list of complications could be better organized and more clearly explained.

The transition to the discussion of Pichler's method could be more fluid. You may want to introduce why this method is significant in the context of your paper.

-your methodology section is well-structured, comprehensive, and detailed. You've described the protocol registration, inclusion and exclusion criteria, search strategy, data extraction, quality assessment tools, and data synthesis approach. This approach is crucial for replication and evaluation of the validity and reliability of your systematic review.

However, there are several areas that you could improve upon or consider further:

Inclusion and Exclusion Criteria: Your inclusion criteria seem clear and relevant. However, you do not provide explicit exclusion criteria. It would be helpful to mention what kind of studies or data were excluded and why.

Search Strategy: You've detailed a wide range of databases, but you should also mention whether you searched for grey literature or consulted any experts. It's important to ensure a comprehensive search in a systematic review. The search terms you've included are clear, but the phrasing of your sentence is a bit awkward. It would be helpful to present the search terms more clearly, perhaps in a tabular form.

Quality Assessment: You've used well-known quality assessment tools, but the explanation could be clearer. The scoring of these tools is somewhat confusing in your current explanation.

Data Synthesis: You've chosen a narrative synthesis due to high heterogeneity among the studies. However, you could provide more detail on how you will conduct this synthesis. What are the key outcomes or variables you'll consider? How will you compare and contrast the results?

-results section is comprehensive and neatly organized. The description of study selection, general characteristics, and the study demographics is clear.
