ABSTRACT

Background: The organization of information is an important process in the overall process of management information in the library. A good organizing information will produce a good collection retrieval results too. But, there has been a problem in the retrieval process. Therefore, it is assumed that there has been a problem which occurred in the process of organizing information as a base process of information retrieval in the library collection. **Objective:** The objective of this study is to describe how the knowledge of classifiers about organizing information is, and to identify the cause of the gaps which is occured in the organizing information process. Conclusion: Metodis classifiers are classifiers who know the purpose of the organizing information, but they do not really know the long-term benefits of organizing information and do not really know how to achieve that benefits. While unmetodis classifiers are classifiers who do not know the purpose and benefits of organizing information.
