

## ABSTRACT

Health service in the hospital would produce some waste, one of them was solid medical waste. This kind of waste could disturb environment's health because many different materials in it could cause health problem and also injury to the workers, patients, hospital's visitors, even the community.

This research was an evaluatif research by comparing the management of solid medical waste at the RSUD Bima, using The Ministree of Health's Decision No. 1204/MENKES/SK/X/2004 about the terms of the hospital's environmental's health.

The result of the research showed that the management of solid medical waste at RSUD Bima didn't use fix procedure but it reffered to the ministree of health's decision RI No. 1204/MENKES/SK/X/2004 about Hospital's Environmental Health. Supporting infrastructure that were used were the plasctic bags of solid medical waste and the transportation was still not in accordance with the regulation. There were 38 officers in managing solid medical waste which 31 of them were high school graduations.

From this research, it can be concluded that the management of solid medical waste at RSUD Bima has been not in accordance with The Ministree of Health's decision No. 1204/MENKES/SK/X/2004. They still uses red plastics bags and there are no differenciate for the color and the type of the waste. The carts of the waste transport is still in an open condition and the waste management officers are less concerned about the using of personal protecting equipment (APD) well. There should be the infrastructure improvements in managing solid medical waste such as incenerator, containers or plastic bags APD, also the carts to transport the waste.
