

## Abstrak

**Hubungan Mother-Daughter Relationship dengan Tingkat Self-Esteem  
Mahasiswa Perempuan Fakultas Kedokteran Universitas Airlangga**

**Latar belakang:** Ibu mempunyai ikatan dan intimasi yang lebih besar daripada hubungan ibu-anak lainnya. Ibu mempunyai peran dalam perkembangan self esteem anak perempuannya. **Tujuan:** untuk menganalisa hubungan antara mother-daughter relationship dengan tingkat self esteem mahasiswa perempuan fakultas kedokteran Universitas Airlangga Surabaya. **Metode:** penelitian ini adalah analitik *cross sectional*. Pengambilan sampel dengan metode cluster random sampling. Sampel terdiri dari 115 mahasiswa perempuan. *Mother-daughter relationship* diukur dengan *Mother-Adult Daughter Questionnaire* (MADQ) dan tingkat self esteem diukur dengan *Rosenberg Self Esteem Scale* (RSES). Data yang terkumpul dianalisa dengan korelasi Pearson. **Hasil:** *Connectedness* dalam *mother-daughter relationship* mempunyai hubungan yang signifikan dengan tingkat *self esteem* ( $p < 0,000$ ;  $r = 0,333$ ). Subskala *interdependency* mempunyai hubungan yang signifikan dengan tingkat *self-esteem* ( $p < 0,016$ ;  $r = 0,025$ ) dan *trust in hierarchy* tidak berkorelasi dengan tingkat *self-esteem*. **Kesimpulan:** *Connectedness* dan *interdependency* dalam *mother-daughter relationship* mempunyai peranan yang penting dalam *self-esteem* anak perempuan. **Kata kunci:** Hubungan ibu-anak perempuan, *self-esteem*

## Abstract

**The Correlation between Mother-Daughter Relationship and Daughter's Self  
Esteem in Female College Student,  
Medical Faculty, Airlangga University, Surabaya**

**Background:** Mother has an *attachment* and greater intimacy than the other parent-child relationship. Mother plays a most important role in the development of self-esteem of their daughters. **Objectives:** To examine correlation between mother-daughter relationship and daughter self-esteem in female college student, medical faculty, Airlangga University, Surabaya. **Method:** This is an analytic cross sectional study. Data were collected using cluster random sampling. The sample was consisting of 115 female college students. Mother-daughter relationship was measured by Mother-Adult Daughter Questionnaire (MADQ). The self esteem was measured by Rosenberg Self Esteem Scale (RSES). The collected data were analyzed using Pearson's correlation. **Result:** *Connectedness* in mother-daughter relationship has significant correlation to daughter's self-esteem ( $p < 0,000$ ;  $r = 0,333$ ). *Interdependency* subscale also has significant correlation to daughter's self esteem ( $p < 0,016$ ;  $r = 0,025$ ) and *trust in hierarchy* subscale did not correlate to daughter's self-esteem. **Conclusion:** *Connectedness* and *interdependency* in mother daughter relationship are important to daughter's self-esteem.
