

## **ABSTRACT**

In its function as a means of protection, the rules of employment law should provide adequate protection for workers, including migrant women workers (TKW). However, empirical facts prove the occurrence of various violations of migrant workers rights as a reflection of ineffectiveness of the migrant workers protection system.
