ISI :

Jawa Timur merupakan Provinsi yang memberikan kontribusi dua per tiga ekonomi Indonesia. Kualitas infrastruktur dan kualitas sumberdaya manusia (IPM) Jawa Timur masih rendah. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis hubungan investasi, modal manusia (pendidikan dan kesehatan), dan infrastruktur terhadap Produk Domestik Regional Bruto (PDRB) Provinsi Jawa Timur. Pendekatan yang digunakan dengan menggunakan metode *Ordinary Least Square* (OLS) untuk melihat elastisitas variabel bebas (*independent*) terhadap variabel terikat (*dependent*). Hasil analisis menunjukkan setiap ada perubahan 1% pada variabel manusia menyebabkan perubahan PDRB sebesar 0,07% dimana variabel lain dianggap tetap; perubahan 1% pada variabel investasi menyebabkan perubahan PDRB sebesar 0,36% dimana variabel lain dianggap tetap; perubahan 1% pada variabel infrastruktur menyebabkan perubahan PDRB sebesar 0,81% dimana variabel lain dianggap tetap; dan jika tidak ada perubahan terhadap variabel modal manusia, investasi, dan infrastruktur maka akan terjadi perubahan PDRB sebesar 2,47% (variabel diluar model).

TEXT :
East Java is known as a province which gives two third of Indonesia's economy activities. However, the quality of its infrastructure and human resources are still categorized at the weak point. This study is aimed to analyze the effect of investment, human resources (education and health) and infrastructure toward Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) of East Java Province. In this study, the researcher happens to use an approach which is basically using the Ordinary Least Square (OLS) method to seek the elasticity of independent variable toward dependent variable. The result shows that in every 1% change of human resources variable, it causes GRDP turning up to 0,07% where the other variables are assumed to be constant; 1% change of investment variable, it causes GRDP turning up to 0,36% where the other variables are assumed to be constant; 1% change of infrastructure variable, it causes GRDP turning up to 0,81% where the other variables are assumed to be constant: and if there is no change toward human resources, investment and infrastructure variable therefore there will be a change toward GRDP up to 2,47% (the variable is outside from the model).
