

ABSTRAK

Widya Aulia Noorsasi, 111111030, Hubungan Antara Big Five Personality Dengan Perilaku Cyberbullying Pada Dewasa Awal, Skripsi, Fakultas Psikologi Universitas Airlangga, 2016. xvi+60 halaman, 6 Lampiran

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui apakah terdapat hubungan antara kepribadian dengan perilaku cyberbullying pada dewasa awal. Kepribadian yang dimaksud disini adalah kepribadian Big Five, sehingga terdapat 5 hubungan yang akan diuji dalam penelitian ini, yaitu: 1) hubungan faktor Neuroticism dengan cyberbullying; 2) hubungan faktor Extraversion dengan cyberbullying; 3) hubungan faktor Openness to Experience dengan cyberbullying; 4) hubungan faktor Agreeableness dengan cyberbullying; 5) hubungan faktor Conscientiousness dengan cyberbullying.

Penelitian dilakukan secara online pada 400 dewasa awal dengan rentang usia 18-25 tahun, laki-laki sebanyak 153 orang dan perempuan sebanyak 247 orang. Alat ukur yang digunakan adalah Big Five Inventory yang sudah diterjemahkan oleh Mukhlisa (2015) dengan aitem sebanyak 44 butir dan kuisioner skala perilaku cyberbullying yang peneliti susun sebanyak 37=8 butir. Analisis data yang digunakan adalah teknik korelasi Spearman's Rho.

Dari hasil analisis data diperoleh nilai signifikansi antara faktor Neuroticism dengan perilaku cyberbullying sebesar 0,638 sehingga tidak berhubungan. Nilai signifikansi faktor Extraversion sebesar 0,085 sehingga tidak berhubungan dengan perilaku cyberbullying. Nilai signifikansi faktor Openness to Experience sebesar 0,779 sehingga tidak berhubungan dengan perilaku cyberbullying. Nilai signifikansi faktor Agreeableness sebesar 0,001 dengan koefisien korelasi -0,16 menunjukkan adanya hubungan berbanding terbalik dengan perilaku cyberbullying. Nilai signifikansi faktor Conscientiousness sebesar 0,105 sehingga tidak berhubungan dengan perilaku cyberbullying. Secara keseluruhan, dapat disimpulkan bahwa kepribadian Big Five tidak berhubungan dengan cyberbullying.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to look for relations between Big Five Personality with cyberbullying perpetration in early adulthood. There are 5 relations that will be tested; 1) the relation between Neuroticism and cyberbullying; 2) the relation between Extraversion and cyberbullying; 3) the relation between Openness to Experience and cyberbullying; 4) the relation between Agreeableness and cyberbullying; 5) the relation between Conscientiousness and cyberbullying.

This study conducted online with 400 respondents between 18 to 25 years old, 153 males and 247 females. The instruments used are Big Five Inventory that has been translated into bahasa by Mukhlisa (2015) with 44 aitem and 38 aitem questionnaire to measure cyberbullying perpetration. The data analysis used is Spearman's Rho correlation.

Signification's value between Neuroticism and cyberbullying is 0,638 meaning that these are not related. Signification's value between Extraversion and cyberbullying is 0,085 meaning that these are not related. Signification's value between Openness to Experience and cyberbullying is 0,779 meaning that these are not related. Signification's value between Agreeableness and cyberbullying is 0,001 with -0,16 correlation's value showed that Agreeableness is negatively correlated to cyberbullying. Signification's value between Conscientiousness and cyberbullying is 0,105 meaning that these are not related. Overall, the results show that Big Five is not related to cyberbullying perpetration.
