PENGARUH PENDAPATAN ASLI DAERAH, DANA ALOKASI UMUM, DANA ALOKASI KHUSUS, DAN DANA BAGI HASIL TERHADAP PERTUMBUHAN EKONOMI KABUPATEN/KOTA DI PROVINSI SUMATERA UTARA.

ISI: Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis pengaruh pendapatan asli daerah, dana alokasi umum, dana alokasi khusus, dan dana bagi hasil terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi kabupaten/kota di Provinsi Sumatera Utara tahun 2011-2016. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode Fixed Effect Model (FEM) dengan metode Generalized Least Square (GLS). Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa variabel independen secara simultan signifikan berpengaruh terhadap variabel dependen. Secara parsial, variabel dana alokasi khusus berpengaruh negatif dan signifikan terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi, sedangkan variabel pendapatan asli daerah, dana alokasi umum, dan dana bagi hasil tidak memiliki pengaruh signifikan terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi kabupaten/kota di Provinsi Sumatera Utara tahun 2011-2016.

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ABSTRACT

THE EFFECT OF REGIONAL OWNED-SOURCED OF REVENUE, GENERAL ALLOCATION FUND, SPECIAL ALLOCATION FUND, AND REVENUE SHARING FUND AGAINST ECONOMIC GROWTH REGENCY/MUNICIPALITIES OF NORTH SUMATERA.

CONTENTS: The purpose of this study is to analyze the effect of regional owned-sourced of revenue, general allocation fund, special allocation fund, and revenue sharing fund against economic growth regency/municipalities of North Sumatera on year 2011-2016. This study uses the Fixed Effect Model (FEM) with methods Generalized Least Square (GLS). The results show that all independent variables simultaneously significant have an effect on dependent variable. Partially, special allocation fund has a negative and significant effect on regional economic growth, meanwhile regional owned-resource of revenue, general allocation fund, and revenue sharing fund have no significant effect against economic growth on districts/cities of the North Sumatera Province in 2011-2016.
