Meta Analysis: Factors Influencing Non Performing Financing of Islamic Banks in Indonesia.

CONTENT:

This study attempts to determining the factors influencing non performing financing of Islamic Banks in Indonesia using samples for seven years (2012-2018) from published journals in Indonesia. The purpose of this research is to examine the association bertween BOPO, GDP, inflation, FDR, CAR, FAR, SBIS, and bank size. This research applies the meta-analysis technique to sample of 17 articles. The articles used are selected studies from Sinta Journal and Google Scholar.

The research shows that BOPO, GDP, inflation, CAR, FAR, and bank size have significant correlation with non performing financing of Islamic banks in Indonesia. Meanwhile, FDR and SBIS have no significant correlation with non performing financing of Islamic banks in Indonesia.
