Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui apakah terdapat hubungan antara dukungan sosial dari keluarga dan teman, *problematic internet use*, *attitude toward cyberbullying*, dan *self-esteem* dengan *cyberbullying* pada mahasiswa remaja akhir. Penelitian ini dilakukan karena masa remaja merupakan masa di mana terdapat transformasi dalam berhubungan dengan keluarga, teman sebaya, dan lingkungan yang dapat meningkatkan gejolak emosi. Remaja dikhawatirkan akan memiliki perilaku agresi, salah satunya adalah *bullying*. Saat ini remaja banyak menggunakan internet, di mana selain memberi kemudahan akses, internet dapat mendorong perubahan perilaku *bullying* menjadi *cyberbullying*.

Hipotesis penelitian ini adalah terdapat hubungan antara faktor-faktor tersebut dengan *cyberbullying*. Penelitian ini dilakukan pada 193 mahasiswa remaja akhir (usia 18-21 tahun). Alat ukur yang digunakan adalah adaptasi dari instrumen *cyberbullying* milik Tudkuea & Laeheem ($\alpha = 0.919$), *Multidimensional Scale of Perceived Social Support* ($\alpha = 0.925$), *Questionnaire of The Frequency and Satisfaction with Social Support* ($\alpha = 0.899$), *The Problematic and Risky Internet Use Scale* ($\alpha = 0.888$), *Attitude Toward Cyberbullying Measurement* ($\alpha = 0.860$), dan *Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale* ($\alpha = 0.8587$). Analisis data dilakukan dengan menggunakan analisis hubungan *Bivariate Pearson Correlation* dan *Bivariate Kendall's Tau*.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan dukungan sosial dari keluarga, *problematic internet use*, *attitude toward cyberbullying*, dan *self-esteem* memiliki hubungan terhadap *cyberbullying* dan tidak ditemukan hubungan antara dukungan sosial dari teman.

ABSTRACT

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The research aims to find out if there is a link between the social support of family and friends, problematic Internet use, attitude toward cyberbullying, and self-esteem with cyberbullying on the late adolescent student. This research is done because adolescence is a time when there is transformation in relation to family, peers, and environment that can improve emotional turmoil. Teenagers are feared to have the behavior of aggression, one of which is bullying. Nowadays many teenagers use the Internet, where in addition to giving ease of access, the Internet can encourage changes in bullying behaviour to be cyberbullying.

This research hypothesis is that there is a link between these factors and cyberbullying. The study was conducted in 193 late adolescent students (aged 18-21 years). The measuring instruments used were adaptations of the cyberbullying instrument by Tudkuea & Laeheem ($\alpha = 0919$), Multidimensional Scale of Perceived Social Support ($\alpha = 0925$), Questionnaire of The Frequency and Satisfaction with Social Support ($\alpha = 0899$), The Problematic and Risky Internet Use Scale ($\alpha = 0888$), Attitude Toward Cyberbullying Measurement ($\alpha = 0860$), and Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale ($\alpha = 0.8587$). Data analysis is conducted using Bivariate Pearson Correlation and Bivariate Kendall's Tau relationship analysis. The results showed social support from the family, problematic Internet use, attitude toward cyberbullying, and self-esteem had a connection to cyberbullying and no relationship found between social support of friends.
