Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menggali dan melihat gambaran secara menyeluruh beserta proses makna kerja dari wartawan yang pernah mengalami kekerasan. Serta dampak dari kekerasan dalam melihat pekerjaan yang dilakukan. Penelitian ini menggunakan subjek sebanyak dua orang wartawan dimana wartawan tersebut pernah mengalami kekerasan sebelumnya. Penelitian ini menggunakan analisis fenomenologi dengan teknik analisis *IPA Study* oleh Pietkiewicz & Smith (2012), menggunakan teori serta kategorisasi makna kerja milik Baumeister (1991) yaitu *work as job*, *work as career*, dan *work as calling*.

Hasil yang diperoleh dari penelitian ini adalah kedua subjek memiliki seluruh tiga kategorisasi makna kerja, dimana kategori pemaknaan akan muncul didalam konteks dan situasi yang berbeda. Kekerasan dianggap sebagai tantangan pada kategori *work as career* dan resiko pekerjaan yang dapat dijadikan pembelajaran dan proses kedewasaan. Sedangkan hal yang membantu menguatkan kembali pemaknaan kerja terletak pada kategorisasi *work as job* mengenai kesejahteraan keluarga, serta *work as calling* mengenai panggilan profesi yang membuatnya mampu untuk menyelesaikan tantangan dalam profesinya, termasuk kekerasan.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to explore and see the overall picture and the meaning of work process of journalists who have experienced violence and the impact of violence in workplace. This study uses the subject of two journalist who has experienced in violence before. This research uses phenomenological analysis with IPA study by Pietkiewicz & Smith (2012), using theory and categorization of work meaning by Baumeister (1991), that is work as job, work as career, and work as meaning.

The results obtained from this study are that both subjects have all three categorizations of work meaning, where the categories will appear in different contexts and situations. Violence is seen as a challenge to categorization of work as job and work as career and the risks of work that can be made as learning and maturation process. While things that help them to reinforce the meaning of work lies in the categorization of work as job on family welfare, and work as calling regarding professional vocation which makes they able to solve challenges in their profession, including violence.
